Sandals Emerald Bay, Exuma was closed in Mid August 2024 for extensive renovations and this continued into September 2024.

Celebration Key in Grand Bahama opened in July 2025, and with its opening came a huge surge in cruise arrivals to the destination.

Cruise arrivals to the Port of Nassau was significantly impacted by severe weather conditions in the Atlantic Ocean that caused heavy swells that heavily impacted sea arrivals to the destination during the month. The rough seas caused multiple ships to cancel voyages.
